Gesher means bridge and this class serves as a link between pre-Bar/Bat Mitzvah schooling and post Bar/Bat Mitzvah Judaic studies. This year the Gesher class has been reformatted to broaden the educational experience for its students.

Hebrew: The language program utilizes the Ulpan method of teaching modern Hebrew, including the learning of grammar as well as building upon existing vocabulary.

Tefillah: Utilizing the Siddur to increase skills and familiarity with the various prayer services

Reading: To maintain and increase the students' facility with the written Hebrew language.

Study of Israel: Current events, geography, places of interest, and global circumstances involving Israel and its neighbors will be examined.

Social Awareness: Helping to prepare the students for a Jewish

life in a secular world will be discussed in preparation for both their present and future lives.
